SUBJECT: Transfer of DHHS Dorothea Dix Hospital Artifacts to the City of Raleigh
– a clarification of position

By this memorandum, the DHHS Property Office is requesting, like on June 5, 2017, through the NCDNCR, the deaccession of state-owned artifacts to the City of Raleigh for the inclusion in a future Dorothea Dix memorial on the Dorothea Dix Park grounds. The artifacts are further detailed on the enclosed Exhibit A, an inventory completed on February 5, 2021, depicting a collection of approximately seventy-four (74) items and some listings containing multiple pieces.

It is the understanding of the DHHS Property Office that the transfer of these artifacts to the NCDNCR is a crucial step in the process of gifting the items to the City of Raleigh.

The NC Department of Administration was consulted on this effort.
