07 NCAC 13B .0602 CAMPING

- 4 (a) A person shall not camp in a state park or recreation area on Division property except:
 - (1) in a designated camping area; and
- 6 (2) <u>under-with a valid camping permit.reservation.</u>
- 7 (b) All camping permits shall be issued at the desired state park or recreation area by an authorized Division
- 8 representative no earlier than the first day of the desired period of continuous and actual occupancy.
- 9 (eb) Reservations for camping permits shall only be accepted in accordance with the provisions of 07 NCAC 13B
- 10 .1205, Reservations.
- 11 (dc) Payment of the camping permit-fee, in full, is required at the time the camping permit is issued or when the
- 12 reservation is made.
- 13 (ed) The maximum period of consecutive overnight camping inon any state park or recreation area Division property
- 14 is 14 days within any 30 day period beginning with the first night of stay. Multiple camping areas within on an
- 15 individual park or recreation area Division property are considered as a single camping facility for determining the
- 16 maximum period of overnight camping within any 30 day period. The maximum consecutive-nights shall be
- 17 extended by the Park Superintendent, upon written request with reasons supporting the extension, if the Park
- Superintendent determines equitable public access, visitor services and staffing levels will not be affected.
- 19 (fe) No camper shall leave a set up camp unattended for more than 12 hours. Any set up camp left unattended for
- 20 more than 12 hours is subject to forfeiture of the campsite. Camping equipment, tents, trailers, recreation vehicles
- and articles on a campsite left unattended for more than 12 hours are subject to removal at the owner's expense and
- 22 use of the campsite.
- 23 (gf) At least one adult, 18 or older, shall accompany each camper group.
- 24 (hg) No campfires shall be left unattended.
- 25 (ih) Tents shall only be used in areas delineated for such use.
- 26 (ji) Connecting to a utility system without payment of required fees is prohibited.
- 27 (ki) A Division representative may designate portions of a park Division property where food products, garbage,
- 28 cosmetics, cleaning supplies and equipment used to cook or store food products are required to be kept in a
- 29 Division supplied food locker, a vehicle, recreational vehicle, or suspended at least 10 feet above the ground
- and four feet horizontally from a post, tree trunk, or other object. Food, garbagegarbage, and cooking equipment
- 31 shall not be stored except as specified in these designated areas. This Paragraph does not apply to food products,
- 32 garbage garbage, and cooking equipment being transported, consumed on being prepared for consumption.
- 33 (1<u>k</u>) Designated camping areas shall be for use by registered campers with a camping permitreservation for that site
- and their guests only.
- 35 (ml) Violation of the terms and conditions of a camping permitreservation issued in accordance with this
- 36 <u>sectionSection</u> is prohibited and shall result in the suspension or revocation of the <u>permit.reservation</u>.
- 37 (n) Group and family campsite checkout time is 3:00 PM on the day of departure.
