**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Winston-Salem City Council, therefore, recommends that the above finding regarding the:

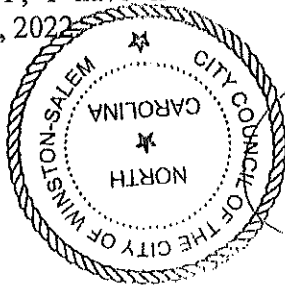
