

- Local Government records stored in courthouse but not always properly preserved
- North Carolina Historical Commission established 1903
- Duty to collect records pertaining to the history of the state
- Assist local governments in managing current records and transferring non-current records
- North Carolina unique in that our State Archives collects local records



Records from one of the counties, just as they were received




COUNTIES WITH RECORDS LOSS DUE TO FIRES, ETC.

- 3 That shortly after the marriage was solemnized the deft declared to several witnesses that as soon as he spent the property he intended to leave the plaintiff.
